



RCSA Policy Statement # 24(b)

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION TO RCSA NATIONAL BLS FACULTY STATUS

1. Current appointment as BLS TC (teaching) Faculty member for at least a 2-year term.
2. Possession of all current AHA Provider and Instructor Manuals for BLS and Heartsaver courses; or access to these via aligned TS.
3. Actively presenting AHA BLS instructor courses as evidenced by at least five courses having been run and actively involved in monitoring as evidenced by at least 20 BLS instructors being monitored.
4. Letter of motivation and nomination by a current BLS National Faculty Member to be endorsed by BLS National Faculty prior to steps below.
5. Evidence of administrative competency, as reflected by appropriate, timely and complete submission of Course documentation, records, and statistics to the RCSA office.
6. Evidence of fulfilment of Faculty responsibilities as per Faculty Responsibilities Document.
7. Successfully monitored (video or in person) by a BLS National Faculty Member teaching on at least one BLS Instructor course.
 - Monitoring fee to be negotiated by potential Faculty and National Faculty performing the monitoring.
8. Since National Faculty members serve as educational experts as well as BLS subject matter experts, a qualification related to education is *highly* recommended and will serve to strengthen the motivation for promotion to National Faculty status.
